Mystic Hunter/Eq/Jumper – no points – red/blue /green warm up – open all day – fence height varies.

CT Training Hunter: CHSA, CHJA Fences 2'6", 2'3", 2', Cross rails 18" Open to all horses or ponies. No age limitations and no rider restrictions. No restriction of horse/pony/rider into other divisions if otherwise eligible. To be judged on performance, soundness, suitability and manners. Simple lead changes and/or trotting in corners are permitted. To be shown over a hunter type course.

Modified Adult Eq: CHJA CHSA NEHC A Open to adult amateur riders. Fences not to exceed 2'6". Riders in this division cannot show in any other recognized classes at the same show where fences exceed 2'6". Riders are eligible for Mod Adult if, as of Dec 1st of the current show year, if they have not show in classes 3' or higher at more than 3 recognized shows in the past 2 show years.

Modified Adult Hunter: CHJA, CHSA, NEHC C- 2'6" Open to adults eligible for Modified Adult Eq.

Adult Amateur Hunter: CHJA, CHSA, NEHC C 2'9"-3'
Junior/AO Hunter- CHJA, CHSA, NEHC – C - 3'3"-3'6"
Per USEF specs

Adult Amateur Eq: CHJA, CHSA, NEHC A - 2'9"-3'

CT Hunter: CHJA, CHSA – High 3'-3'3" Low 2'9"-3'
open to all horses

Short Stirrup Eq- CHJA, CHSA, NEHC A- Cross Rails - Riders 12 and under never shown fences over 18".

Short Stirrup Hunter - CHJA, CHSA, NEHC B- as SS Eq

Long Stirrup Eq - CHSA – Riders 13 and over in first years of showing. Fences not to exceed 2'.

Long Stirrup Hunter – CHSA same as Long Stirrup Eq
NEHC Adult Medal: fences not to exceed 3'. Open to adult /amateur members

NEHC Junior Medal: fences not to exceed 3'3" open to junior members

CHJA Junior Medal: Fences 3'. Opt tests:1-19

CHJA Adult Medal: Fences 3'. Opt tests: 1-19

CHJA Pony Medal: Fences 2' (small), 2'3" (medium), 2'9" (large) Opt tests 1-19

CHJA Mod Adult Medal: Fences 2'6" Opt tests 1-8.

CHJA Children's Medal: Fences 2'6" Junior members who are eligible for children's hunter and have not jumped over 3' at a recognized show including CHJA Junior Medal Finals. Riders are excluded if they have ever qualified or shown in any 3' medal finals. Opt tests: 1-8.

CHJA Pre Children's Medal Rider to be a Junior member of the CHJA who has not shown over fences exceeding 2'6" at a recognized horse show. If a rider has ever qualified for or shown in a 2'6" Equitation final including the CHJA Children's Medal, they are no longer eligible for the Pre Children's Medal. Opt tests 1-8.

CHSA Short Stirrup Medal: Fences 18'

CHSA Pre Children's Eq Medal: Fences 2'

Pre Adult Hunter- CHSA 2'

CHSA Intermediate Children's Eq Medal Fences 2'3" Open to any rider that has not shown over 2'6". Cannot show in both CHSA 2'3" Medal and CHSA 2'6" Medal at same show.

CHSA Children's Eq Medal: Fences 2'6"

CHSA Modified Adult Eq Medal: Fences 2'6"

Pre-Children's Hunter - CHJA, CHSA, NEHC C Fences 2' Open to junior riders who are eligible for Limit equitation over fences as of December 1 of the current show year and have never shown over fences exceeding 2'6" at a recognized horse show. Riders may show horses or ponies. At the same show, horse/rider and pony/rider combinations may not cross enter into Children's Hunter Horse/Pony, Pony Hunters or any class where fences exceed 2'6". No combinations permitted.

Pre-Children's Eq –CHJA, CHSA Fences 2' Open to Juniors eligible for Pre Children's Hunters. May not enter into an eq medal over 2'.

Children's Hunter Horse: CHJA, CHSA NEHC B- 3'.

Children's Hunter Ponies - CHJA, CHSA NEHC B – 2' small/med & 2'6" large

Junior Eq – CHJA, CHSA - 3' Riders may not cross enter into children's equitation

Children's Hunt Seat Eq - CHJA, CHSA, NEHC A- 2'6" horses and large ponies, 2' sm and med ponies. May not cross enter into Junior Equitation must be eligible for Children's Hunters, never shown over 3' and never shown in the CHJA Junior Medal Finals.

Modified Children's Hunter – CHJA , CHSA- to be ridden by Jr. Exhibitors who are eligible for Children's Eq. Open to both horses or ponies – 2'6" No combinations. Same horse rider combination cannot enter any over fence classes exceeding 2'6".

Knee High Jumper: 2'3" open to all horses

Low Training Jumper – CHJA, CHSA - Fences 2'6"-3'

1.0 m Jumper – 3'3" open to all horses

WTC Hunt Seat Eq: CHSA Open to all ages , jr/am who have never shown o/f at a recognized show.

M & S Child/Adult Jumper Classic - 3'5"

M & S Hunter Classics – The numerical score of the 1st round will be combined with that of the 2nd round.

M&S Adult Hunter Classic - 3'

M&S Children's Hunter Horse/Pony Classic - 3' horses
2'6" large 2' sm/med

Bit O' Straw Hunter Classic- Open to Jr. or Amateur riders. No cross entry of horse/pony or rider into M & S children's or adult Hunter Classic 2'6"

M&S Junior Medal 3' Open to Junior riders.

M&S Adult Medal 3' Open to Adult Amateur Riders.

M&S Children's Medal Horse/Pony 3' horses 2'6" large 2' med/sm Open to Jr Riders on horses who are not competing at the same show in any hunter or equitation class in which the fences exceed 3'3"

M&S 2'6" Adult Medal – open to adult amateur riders that are not competing over 3' at same show

M&S 2'6" Child Medal - open to Junior riders that are not competing over 3' at same show.

2'9" Hunter Derby - CHJA, CHSA, NEHC – AA This is a 2 round class open to all riders to be shown over a course of ten fences at 2'9" with higher options. The first round judged on performance, hunter pace, and style, quality and substance, and movement. The course should include at least one in and out, one bending line and one unrelated distance. The obstacles are to simulate those found in a hunt field. Natural obstacles may be used. The top 4 or 25% from the first round will return to jump a handy hunter round of eight obstacles which may include at least two of the following: trot jump, tight turn option, clever options for jump approach, halt and/or back and walk jump. To be judged on style, brilliance, and handiness. Judges will adhere to USHJA Hunter Derby rules for scoring. The score will be a total of the two rounds. To fill a class, at least 4 riders must compete. **2'6" Jr/Am Hunter Derby** - CHJA, CHSA, NEHC –AA, same specs as 2'9" Derby **2'-2'3" Jr/Am Hunter Derby** – CHJA, CHSA, same specs as 2'9" Derby **2'3" Hunt Teams – 1 round – open to any 2 or 3 rider/horse combinations.**

RULES & REGULATIONS 1. EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULEBOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH. Unless otherwise specified, all hunter classes to be judged on performance and soundness. Every class offered herein which is recognized by the CHJA/NEHC/CHSA will be conducted and judged in accordance with the current CHJA//NEHC/CHSA Rules. To show in CHJA & NEHC Medal classes, riders MUST be members. In order to compete for CHJA/CHSA/NEHC annual year-end awards, the owner of the horse or pony must be a member of the CHJA/NEHC/CHSA and the horse or pony must be registered with the CHJA/NEHC/CHSA. A copy of the CHJA/ NEHC/CHSA Rule Books, class specifications, Medal class specifications, and membership applications are available at the show secretary's office and at www.chja.net, www.nehc.info & www.chsaonline.com

2. Every animal entered for competition shall be under the control of show management; but Mystic Valley Hunt Club, Inc. will in no way be responsible for any loss, accident or damage that may occur by fire or otherwise and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor, spectator, trainer and attendant hold Mystic Valley Hunt Club, Inc., and its members, employees and agents harmless for any loss or damage that may occur to any persons, animals or property at the show.

3. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any classes if in its opinion the entries so warrant, while maintaining minimum USEF requirements to fill a class. 4. Course diagrams will be posted at least one hour prior to each class. 5. Prize Money will be applied against the exhibitor's account. Any remaining balance will be mailed to the owner on record within 30 days of the completion of the show. No prize money will be issued without proper Social Security or Tax ID Numbers. 6. Sharps containers MUST be used the location of which will be available at the secretary's office. 7. Open checks and Measurement Cards must be presented and verified by the show secretary prior to issuing any numbers. Responsibility lies with the exhibitor to possess all needed membership & measurement cards. Any fines issue to the horse show will be the responsibility of the exhibitor. 8. All dogs must be leashed at all time. 9. Office Fee: \$20. 10. Stalls with doors are available at \$40 per day. 11. Returned checks or unpaid entries are subject to a \$25 fee plus any bank service charges. 12. Credit cards (Master Card & Visa) are accepted. 13. All classes \$25. \$40 for stakes, classics, and medals unless otherwise noted. \$150 Classic \$45 \$250 Classic-\$55 \$300 Classic - \$65 \$500 - Classic - \$85. 14. Entries are due by 6p of the night prior to the show. A \$20 post entry fee will be assessed after that and on the day of the show. 15. Hunter Classics are 2 rounds, comprised of the 3rd round of the division and an additional Classic round. NEHC, CHJA, and CHSA points are not awarded for the additional Classic round. The same rider must ride both rounds of the Classic. 16. To be eligible to compete in a hunter derby, the horse must show in one other class at the horse show. 17. To be eligible to compete in a stake or classic, exhibitors must enter and compete in at least 2 other classes in that division. Stake classes 1st \$20, 2nd \$15, 3rd \$10, 4th \$5. \$100 Classics - 1st \$40, 2nd \$30, 3rd \$20, 4th \$10. \$150 Classics - 1st \$55, 2nd \$40, 3rd \$25, 4th \$15, 5th \$10, 6th \$5. \$250 Classics - 1st \$90, 2nd \$70, 3rd \$40, 4th \$30, 5th \$20, \$500 Classics - 1st \$160, 2nd \$120, 3rd \$90, 4th \$60, 5th \$40, 6th \$30. 18. NEHC \$2 show fee will be accessed for every horse entered.
