Rules and Regulations

1. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book and M&S requirements and will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
2. Entry Fee is \$15 per class unless stated otherwise. Office Fee is \$10.00 per entry.
3. Entry Fees for the M&S classes are \$25 per class. Classics and Medals are \$30 per class.
4. Warm-ups will be allowed before each hunter and equitation jumping division for horses/ponies in that division. Warm-up fees are \$15 per horse per warm-up.
5. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide classes if warranted. Management also reserves the right to vary the officials, including the judges, if necessary, and to change the courses at their discretion.
6. Entries are due by 5 p.m. the night before the show. Any entry after this is considered a post entry and will be charged a \$15 post entry fee.
7. Hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted. Equitation classes to be judged seat, hands, guidance and control of horse.
8. All entries must be signed by the Owner/Trainer and Rider (or Parent/Guardian) prior to picking up your show number.
9. Exhibitors must be in proper safety attire for all classes.
10. A processing fee of \$25 shall be charged for each non negotiable check.
11. All dogs must be leashed at all times.
12. Every animal entered for competition shall be under the control of the committee, but MVHC, Inc., will in no way be responsible for any damage that may occur and it shall be a condition of every entry that each exhibitor shall hold MVHC, Inc., as well as the Show Committee harmless for any loss or accident which may occur. Should any question or dispute arise, it shall be referred to the Show Committee whose decision is final.
13. Horse and Rider must compete at at least 3 shows to qualify for year end Silver Snaffle Awards.

Silver Snaffle Awards

We will be awarding prizes for first place and reserve for a series award in all divisions. All 4 MVHC schooling shows will count toward these awards. Horse or Rider must compete at 3 shows to qualify.

Point will be awarded as follows:

1st – 10, 2nd-6, 3rd – 4, 4th – 2, 5th – 1 and 6th – ½
